## INSURANCE – INSURANCE – INSURANCE

ALL students enrolled at Knollwood Christian Academy for the 2022-2023 school year are requested to have insurance (provided by the parents' health policy) to cover injuries from accidents while at school. If you do not have health insurance, you will need to sign an insurance waiver on the back of the Medical Release form.

NOTE: If your insurance has changed recently or if it changes throughout the school year, please let the office have a copy of your new insurance card. We need this to be current in case of a medical emergency.

## IMMUNIZATIONS

**Do not wait until the last minute to have your child immunized!**

It is an Alabama State Law that your child has a current certificate of immunization. This needs to be turned in on or before the first day of school or your child will need to remain out of school until we receive it.

Students entering K5 are required to have an MMR shot by age 5 (depending on their birthday). If a student is already enrolled, and we have an up-to-date immunization form, it is not necessary to bring another one. Also, proof of immunity to varicella (chickenpox) will be required for students in five-year-old kindergarten.

A dose of Tdap vaccine will be required for Alabama students ages 11 or 12 entering 6th grade. You can minimize the rush by getting your child vaccinated early.

### 2nd – 8th Grade

You may order PE uniforms at Meet the Teacher. Orders will be filled the first week of school.

## Kindergarten Mats

- All K3, K4, and K5 students are required to have a sleeping mat. We will have available “Kid Nappers”, which come in bright colors, are machine washable, and are made with a sewn-in sheet. The cost is \$30 per mat. You may buy one of these through the school while supplies last.

Hot lunches for the upcoming school year will be \$5 (includes milk or juice). Extra milk/juice is 75 cents.

Lunch menus are sent home each month.

## MEDICATIONS

If your child has allergies that require inhalers, breathing treatments, epi pens, etc., please notify the teacher and the office staff at the start of school. Other medications may be left at the office with a permission note and dosage amount.
